## Pumpkin Ice Drop Earring

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This earring is made following the same instructions as the Pumpkin Ice Drop pendant, just different stitch counts.

The Balanced stitch ring at the center is 8 - 1 - 8

Round 2 chain: Begin with a sm picot then

Chain 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 + 1 - 1 + 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 +

Round 3 ( no rings in this round for the smaller Ice Drop )

Chain 1 - 1 - 1 +

repeat around.

Back side

Chain 1 + 1 + 1 turn

Ring1 ( 3 - 2 - 3 ) turn

\*

Chain 1 + 1 + 1 turn

Ring ( 3 + 2 - 3 ) turn

\*

Repeat between \* \* around.

Insert the Ice Drop before the final ring.

Final Ring 3 + 2 + 3 turn Chain 1 Tie the ends to the beginning of the back side.

Tighten the back, if needed, the same as with the pendant.

Clover (leaf) R1 ( 4 - 2 - 2 ) R2 ( 2 + 5 - 5 - 2 ) R3 ( 2 + 2 - 4 )

Tie the green thread where the orange thread ends are at the top of the pumpkin. I ran a green thread end through the center picot of the leaf then back to the top to hold it in place. This is a good idea for the pendant too.

I did a pearl tatting stem, and then I tied all four thread ends in a double overhand knot. Cut the orange thread ends, and add a clear bead to the green thread ends. The ring at the top with the earring hook is 8 DS.

Sadly I missed joining to one picot of the orange thread and it shows my mistake in the photo. It is glaringly obvious to me, but I doubt others will notice it when I am wearing my earrings. Just me, proving once again, that I am not perfect. Everyone makes mistakes.
