

# Snowflake in a Snowflake

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This is an intermediate level pattern, with two shuttles, and one split ring used to climb from the first round to the second round. While the design is simple, this is a good pattern to improve tension and attention to detail.



Wind two shuttles full CTM.

Begin with S1  
Center Ring ( 3 – 3 – 3 ) Turn  
Chain 8 turn  
Ring ( 3 – 2 – 3 ) turn  
Chain 8 turn



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S2 Center ring ( 3 + 3 – 3 ) turn  
S1 Ring ( 3 – 3 ) turn  
Chain 8 turn  
Ring ( 3 – 2 – 3 ) turn  
Chain 8 [ Repeat around ]

The sixth center ring joins to both the previous center ring and the first center ring.



Tat the final Chain 8 turn  
Ring ( 3 – 2 – 3 ) turn  
Chain 8.  
←Join to the beginning of the first Chain 8 as shown.

Split ring ( 3 / 3 )

Round 2  
Chain 8 + turn  
Clover →  
Chain + 8 + 8 +

<p>Clover: Ring1 ( 3 – 3 – 3 – 3 ) Ring2 ( 3 + 5 – 1 – 1 – 5 – 3 ) Ring3 ( 3 + 3 – 3 – 3 ) turn</p>
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Repeat around, then join the end to the beginning of this round.  
Tie the ends to make a loop for hanging. No ends to hide.

For a star instead of a snowflake, do it with 4 or 5 repeats instead of 6. Add beads if you wish.
